- B. Race Fees Financial Spreadsheet-Update/Paula/Ron
 - estimated budget spreadsheet for 2017 was reviewed. The proposed budget includes projected income and expenses for 2017 and 2016. An approved budget would drive decisions on future expenditures. To be discussed further at the next meeting.
- C. Consider Premier Races for 2017- Update/Ron
 - 1. Bill Beauchamp 10k. Could make this a special race by awarding door prizes, have a food truck, special finish line, etc.
 - 2. Tantalus 10 miler. Not under further consideration as a premier race due to parking and safety concerns.
 - 3. Bellows. No permission to hold a race.
 - 4. Windward Half Marathon (2017). Boys & Girls Club sponsors the race and receives proceeds; perhaps it's possible to split proceeds with them? Castle Medical Center has sponsored in the past and could be approached again. There are typically700-800 finishers. Includes a 5K race. Consider for 2017 if possible, or 2018. will continue to check with them.
- D. Annual Meeting Date & Place Selection and Activities-
 - 1. KCC dates Update/Joy/Halina.

- KCC was tentatively reserved for March 24 as other venues are explored. An earlier date would be preferable. The Elks Club is not available in January or February. will look into the Japanese Cultural Center which is available on Feb. 10.

- 4. By-Law and Constitution Changes –Audit Requirement/Joy
- Proposed change in the Constitution: replace "audit" with another term such as "evaluate" or "assess". "Review" is also not appropriate.
- In order to offer a special membership rate for those who sign up at the Expo, must change the Bylaws to authorize the Board to change membership fees.
- Proposed: Staggered 2 year terms for half the Board members, and the other half the next year, to ensure continuity among Board members.

 - 1. MPRRC & RRCA Expo-Update/Ron

 - will distribute the volunteer guide to all those who staff the booth. He will also create a magnet-size card with the 2017 race schedule if we run out of magnets. Will also hand out a sheet describing places to go for group training runs.
 - 2. Marathon Tent Update-Ron/Joan
 - talked to will contribute to the cost of the tent. He will also arrange for volunteers.
 - to ask to send an email to recruit volunteers for the marathon tent.
 - to make sure that each group has noticeable signage.
 - The Valley Isle Road Runners (VIRR) would like to use the tent after the marathon and will pay for their runners. will get a list of their runners and give to their success. Other guests are ok too, provided we get headcount and names in advance. The cost is \$10 for food and \$15 for massage.
