Windward Half Marathon Readiness Series

- Packet pick-ups are all scheduled at the Running Room. May need to add a packet pick-up on the Windward side for the 10-miler.
- Awards Need to arrange awards for the top finishers and use current MPRRC medals for age group winners. will inventory the medals during the next trip to the storage locker.
- Shirt Need a shirt design. will follow-up with the Honolulu Shirt Shop. also urged that we re-emphasize with members and participants that there is only one shirt for the series as this is a significant change from prior years.
- Race 1: Bob & Ron's Manoa 5K: will verify that we have permission to use the Manoa Rec. Center facilities.
 - There are restrooms but it was recommended that we get 2 portable toilets to supplement.
 - o Coning directional coning only.
 - o Police Joan will set it up with the permit.
- Race 2: Chapson Diamond Head Dash 8K: will speak with permission to use the facilities at KCC. to check on access to bathrooms.
 - o There are rest rooms but it was recommended that we get 2 portable toilets.
 - Coning will follow-up with a coning plan as well as potential Bus rerouting on race day.
 - o Police will follow-up. Probably need more than 10.
- Race 3: Johnny Faerber 10K: Nothing new here same as last year.
- Race 4: Kailua 10-miler:
 - o School use permit is tentatively approved pending certificate of insurance.
 - Course The course is set but need a coning plan, aid station locations, course marshal locations, and police instructions. Maybe can help. will run the course in the next couple of weeks to get ideas about these issues. has agreed to certify the course for about \$800.
 - O It was approved to spend a maximum of \$800 plus tax to certify the new Kailua 10 mile race course.

- Course will contact GP Roadway Systems regarding the coning plan and cost.
