  - will email last year's runners; advertised via Facebook, email, etc.
  - will mark course with arrows at the "intersection", past the gate.
  - will provide refreshments.

  - Trophies to be delivered in advance.
  - will get equipment and staff the water station.
- b. Tantalus (Sun., Oct. 14) Joan Davis
  - Still no response from the school principal.
  - Need a crew to pick up and set up equipment.
  - 3 water stops at 2.5, 5.0 and 7.5 miles. Running clockwise.
  - 30 minute early start for walkers. **1** to so indicate on RunSignUp. Early starters should be required to have lights since will still be dark.
- c. Pride Run (Sat. Nov. 3) Halina Zaleski
  - Last month's decision was amended to approve MPRRC getting 20% of proceeds (not 80%).
  - Include a flyer in the 20K race packet.

  - 7 am, Noelani School, Manoa

- No megaphone or speakers at race start since in residential area.
- f. Chapson 8K (Sunday, January 20, 2019)
  - 7 a.m. Moved back to original course at Kapiolani Park. To coincide with GAR training run.
  - Permit approved.
- g. Faerber 10K (Sunday, February 3, 2019)

  - Permit approved.
- h. GAR Readiness Series.
  - Met with the Great Aloha Run staff on August 13<sup>th</sup>. Partnership has been agreed to.
  - Approved: four-race series, with the GAR as the 4<sup>th</sup> race. Other races in the series are the Bob & Ron's 5K, Chapson 8K, and Faerber 10K. Lowest cumulative race time receives awards. Only MPRRC members will be eligible for awards.
  - Only one shirt for 3 of the races; a separate shirt will be given for the Great Aloha run.
- i. Kailua 10-miler (Sunday, February 24, 2019) Ron Alford and another race director needed
  - 6:30 am, Kailua High School
  - Michael Garrison will sponsor the race and provide race shirts.
- j. Windward Half Marathon (Sunday, March 24, 2019) Kawika Carlson, Ron Alford and Taylor Mower (BSA).
  - Scouts BSA (Boy Scouts of America) will be the charity partner for this race.
  - Location pending, e.g., a Kailua school or B&G Club. to inquire of B&G Club.
  - If new course, must be re-certified.
  - BSA can provide course marshals.
  - BSA interested in a 1 mile and/or 5K race for their members.
  - BSA can assist in designing the shirt.
  - Proceeds split 50/50, after expenses paid.
- k. Mother's Day 10K (Sunday, May 12, 2019) Halina Zaleski
  - UH Urban Garden Center, Pearl City
  - Race will start at 6:30, not 7:00 as in previous years.
  - Keiki run and baking contest.
