Summary of Actions Taken By the Board

- A. Race Committee Ron Alford
 - 1. Races
 - a. Old Pali Road Run Betty Gail Alford; Sunday, September 9, 2019, Recap
 - Lack of parking an issue; may need to shuttle runners to the start in the future.
 - Need to deter cars from entering the roadway through the gate after the race. Maybe close the gate after the last runner passes; or place a barrier so cars can't get through.
 - b. Pride Run (Frontrunners Event) Halina Zaleski; Saturday, October 12, 2019, 7:00 a.m.
 - c. Tantalus 10-Mile Challenge Betty Gail Alford & Joan Davis; Sunday, October 13, 2019, 6:30 a.m.
 - Ed to send out mass emails on both races (Pride Run and Tantalus).
 - Joan will reconfirm about truck rental and equipment pick up with Erwin.
 - May need more volunteers, unless the school volunteers their students. There should be at least one adult at each aid station.
 - Betty Gail getting trophies.
 - Shirts should be done soon; there is an early shirt count.
 - Slower runners can start earlier at 6:00, but will not be eligible for awards.
 - 4 boxes of glow sticks can be distributed to runners who will be running in the dark.
 - Moving start line so finish line can be in a safer place.
 - Cap is 200 runners.
 - d. Santa Hat 5K Fun Run/Walk Ron Alford; Sunday, December 1, 2019, 7:00 a.m.
 - Medals done; ordered Santa chair; police officer will be Santa.

- 2. Rotary Club International Convention 2020 Joan Davis
 - Need written agreement between MPRRC and RCI on duties and responsibilities
 - Run is scheduled for June 6, 2020, which is also Global Running Date
- 3. Expos Ron Alford
 - Stickers are here for distribution.
 - Approved to order 50 male and 50 female singlets, in a variety of sizes. Betty Gail to order them.
- 4. MPRRC 2020 Race Schedule Ron Alford
 - Has been included in the race committee September minutes.
 - Race committee recommended moving the Lanikai race to Sunday, July 26 (instead of July 19).
 - Race directors for the 3 Aloha Readiness Series races should decide whether there will be a series shirt or one for each of the 3 races.
 - Approved offering the member rate for the Aloha Readiness Series races for those who attend the GAR in-training sessions.
 - Consider adding a 5K to the Mother's Day race schedule.
- 5. Race Promotion Ron Alford
 - Summit Media is preparing a promotional package for MPRRC to consider.
 - Ron will provide Ed access to RunSignUp so he can add new members to his email listserv.
- 6. Medals for races Betty Gail Alford
 - The Board to revisit the proposal to have larger age group medals in fall 2020 when the supply of current medals is depleted.
- 7. World Airline Road Race 2020 Joan Davis
 - October 2020. About 1,000 runners to participate in a short run; specific date not set; not sure if open to the public.
 - MPRRC needs to develop an agreement.
 - Also, MPRRC may again lead the cruise run in October.
- 8. RRCA Race Director Certification Ron Alford
 - An on-line race director certification proposal was approved. MPRRC will provide a scholarship for two members to take the course (\$250 per person). In return, they must direct at least two club races for at least two consecutive years.
 - Application process: Ron to send instructions to MPRRC members.
 - Selection committee to be determined.

 - Joan, Chris, and Ed to make recommendations to the Board on volunteer shirts and other committee activities.
 - Joan conveyed her appreciation to the volunteers at the Old Pali Road race in her absence.
